1. CAQH (Council for Affordable Quality Health Care will host a series of trainings for FQHCs interested in getting their providers credentialed through their process.

DAS Demo Dates - Tuesday, March 10, 2009, 10am – 11:30am (EST) – Data Access System (DAS) training will focus on: How to navigate the DAS, upload rosters, download files, generate reports, search for providers, and view provider applications. This session should be attended by your users and administrators that seek to understand how Participating Organizations work with CAQH systems.

OAS Demo Dates - Tuesday, March 17, 2009, 10am – 11:30am (EST) – Online Application System (OAS) training will focus on: How the provider will use the system to complete the CAQH online application. The module includes step by step instructions for using the OAS as well as describes what's needed for attestation/reattestation of providers. This session should be attended by provider relations/credentialing staff as well as clinicians. We will be hosting these sessions at the RWJ Conference Center. The fee for sessions will be \$50.00 per attendee to cover the costs of refreshments and meeting space.

2. The NJPCA will be hosting a meeting for all MIS staff to get briefed on the many uses of the UDS data and how this can help improve operations. Target Date: Late April or early May. No fee - limit of 25 people to be held at the NJPCA offices.

3. Clinical Quality Reunion Meeting - All clinical teams are invited to attend this 1.5 day session at the Marriott in Princeton NJ. Fees to be determined. Tentative Dates - May 28th and 29th

Provider Coding training which is four to five-hour curriculum developed for training health center providers on how to properly apply Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) coding to patient visits and the relationship of visit coding to the documentation in the patient record. Class content and concepts are specifically designed for educating health center clinicians on how to select the most appropriate Evaluation and Management code, at the point of service, utilizing Medicare's E&M Documentation Guidelines. Date is June 19th. Fee \$75 to be held at the RWJ Conference Center in Hamilton
