This one-day UDS training will cover the preparation of the 2010 UDS Report including recent changes to several tables, the UDS editing and submission process, as well as the differences between the UDS and the other BPHC data collection tool, the HCQR (ARRA Health Center Quarterly Report). The training will address each of the UDS tables, including a discussion of the changes that have been made and the definitions necessary to complete the reports. Because of continued problems with submission of the clinical measures tables (Table 6B and 7), these will once again be covered extensively. This training is aimed at health center staff who are responsible for gathering and reporting the data elements included in the UDS report as well as for management staff who need to understand the definitions and concepts used in the UDS report.

**About the UDS:** The UDS is a reporting requirement for grantees of the following primary care programs administered by the BPHC, HRSA: Community Health Center, Migrant Health Center, Health Care for the Homeless, Public Housing Primary Care, and any Section 330 funded Health Center. The UDS collects basic demographic information on patients you serve (e.g. race/ethnicity and insurance status of patients, etc.). UDS data are analyzed by HRSA to ensure compliance with legislative mandates, report program accomplishments, and justify budget requests to the U.S. Congress. The UDS also helps to identify trends over time to enable HRSA to establish or expand targeted programs, identify effective services and interventions to improve access to primary health care for vulnerable populations.
